	"This Council recognises the importance of the simple activity of walking and getting out of the house as part of a healthy lifestyle. Safe footways are especially important for the elderly if they are to feel confident enough to walk to their local shops and services and continue to take part in their community. We are concerned that the county's footways budget of only £800,000 in 2014/15 is totally inadequate to maintain our footways and that the inspection criteria are insufficiently rigorous to identify where the surface is unsafe for less able workers.
	We call on the Cabinet to increase the proportion of the total highways maintenance budget that is allocated to footway maintenance in 2015/16 and to consider a new capital project for footway improvements in the coming year to be spread across all councillors' divisions."
