Notice of Motion 2 – Badgers and bovine TB (bTB)	7. This motion is not in relation to the exercise of an executive function and the Council may decide to determine the Motion.
	8. Notice of Motion standing in the names of Mr P M McDonald, Mr R M Udall, Mr P Denham, Mr C J Bloore and Ms P Hill:
	"This Council notes the serious and damaging animal welfare and economic impact that bovine TB (bTB) has on the farming community. This Council also notes that the Government's 'solution' to bTB is shooting large numbers of free-running badgers at night; a proposal that has met with fierce criticism from the public, eminent scientists and animal welfare charities. This Council is concerned that the Government has ignored public, Parliamentary and scientific opinion by ploughing ahead with the badger cull this summer in a cruel and ineffective attempt to tackle bTB.
	This Council believes that the Government would better serve the farming community by investing money in vaccinations for badgers and cattle and encouraging farmers to improve bio-security in order to achieve the long-term eradication of this disease in livestock.
	This Council resolves to write to the Secretary of State at the Department of Environment, Farming and Rural Affairs to:

	 highlight the Council's concern about the practicalities as well as the welfare implications of the current proposed cull object to any cull taking place on Worcestershire County Council-owned land, and call on the Government to seek alternative methods to tackle the problem of bTB."
