## Summary

# **Background**

- 2. NHS England is the national commissioner of community pharmacy services, and its role is to ensure the NHS provides safe, effective, high quality patient care and services within community pharmacy.
- HOSC members are aware of the recent announcement from the Department of Health which will mean reductions to funding arrangements, as part of working with NHS England over the next five years to develop how services can be delivered differently.
