UPDATE ON PLACE PARTNERSHIP LIMITED

Summary

1. The Cabinet Member with Responsibility for Transformation and Commissioning, the Head of Commercial and colleagues from Place Partnership Ltd (PPL) have been invited to the meeting to update Members on how the County Council's relationship with PPL is developing.

Background

2. On 15 November 2016 (during the previous Council) the Corporate and Communities O&S Panel received a briefing on Place Partnership Limited (PPL).
3. Following the Elections in May 2017, it is timely for the new Panel to receive a further update on Place Partnership Limited covering how the County Council's relationship with PPL is developing and providing background information for new and returning Members.

Place Partnership Limited

4. The proposal for Place Partnership Limited was approved by Cabinet in 2014.
5. PPL is the first multi-agency joint property vehicle of its kind. It is a private company wholly owned by a number of private sector bodies, delivering innovative property services.
6. PPL have been invited to attend the meeting to discuss how their relationship with the County Council has developed over the last year, including achievements to date.
