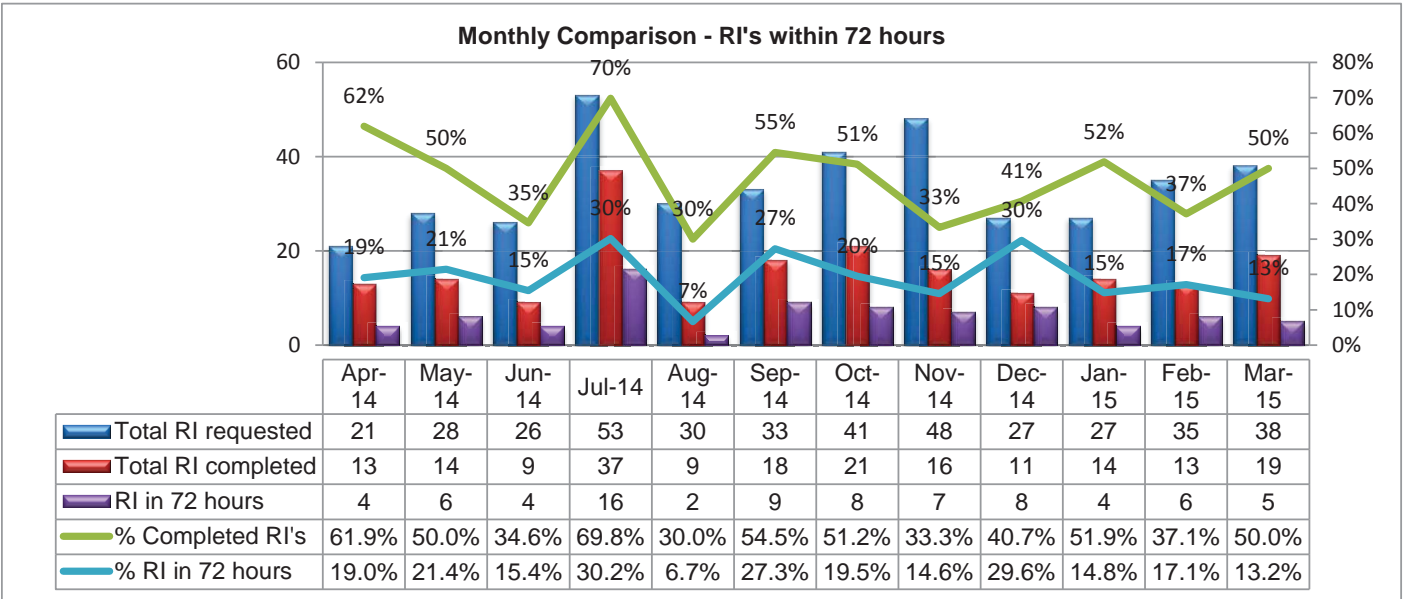
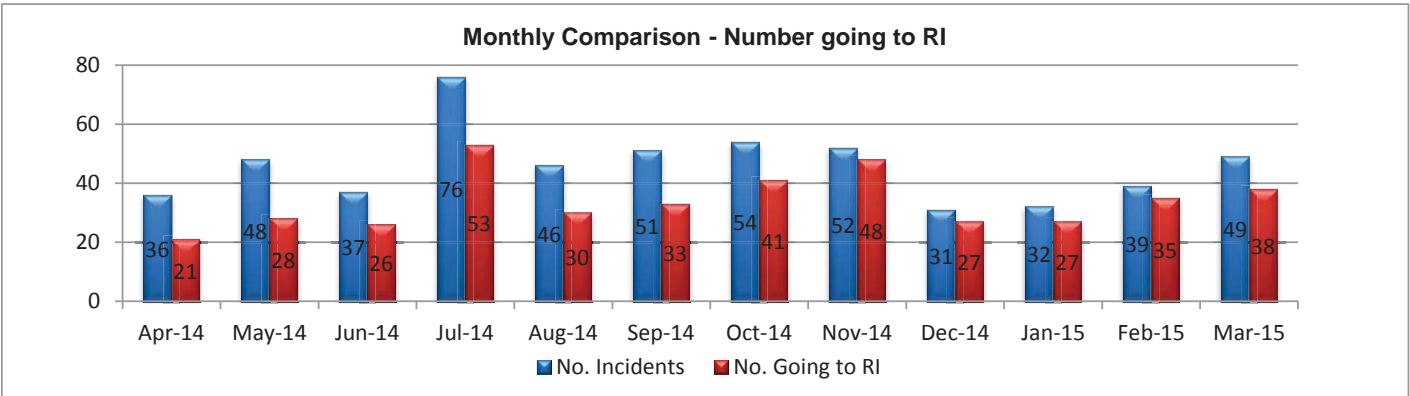

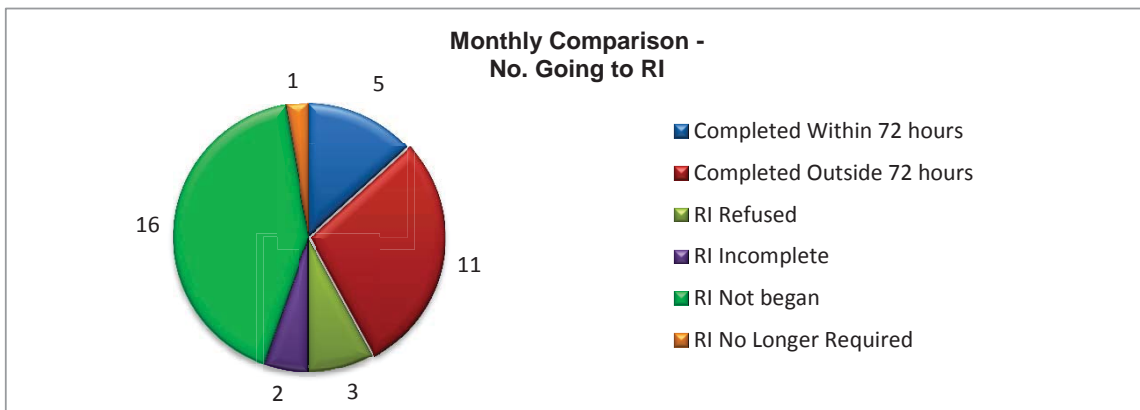
**1: Number of Return Interviews (RI) completed within 72 hours from the child being found**

This indicator measures the number of return interviews that have taken place for children and young people (C&YP) that have gone missing from home or care, where a professional judgement\* has deemed them necessary. The timescales for the return interviews to be undertaken is 72 hours from the time the missing person has been found.

\*Professional Judgement is based upon the circumstances surrounding the child or young person's missing episode, such as whether they have been harmed, involved in criminal activity, number of missing episodes, or other intelligence provided by West Mercia Police (Safe & Well check)

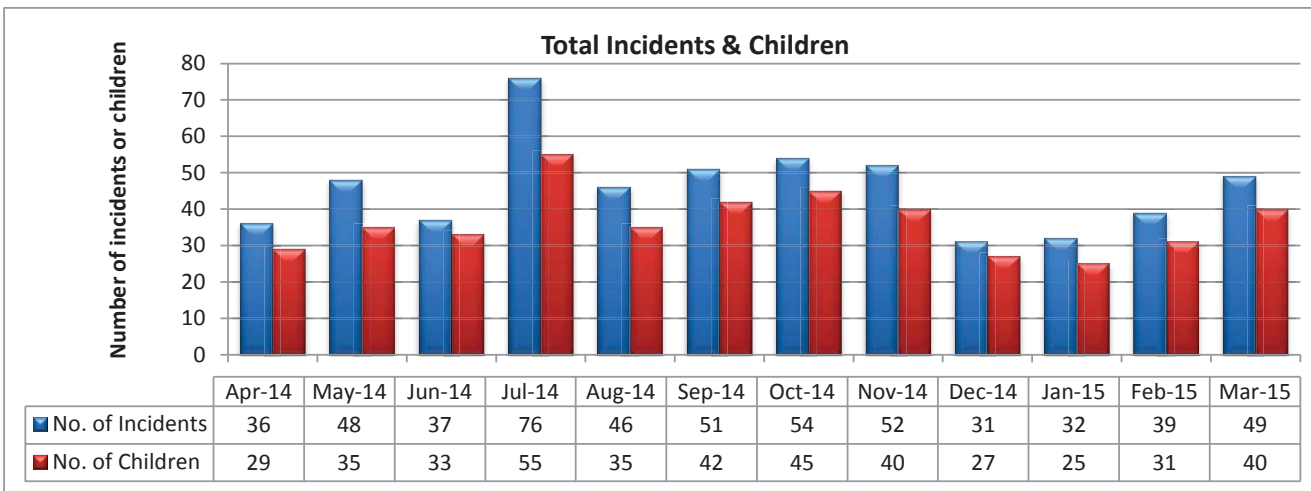

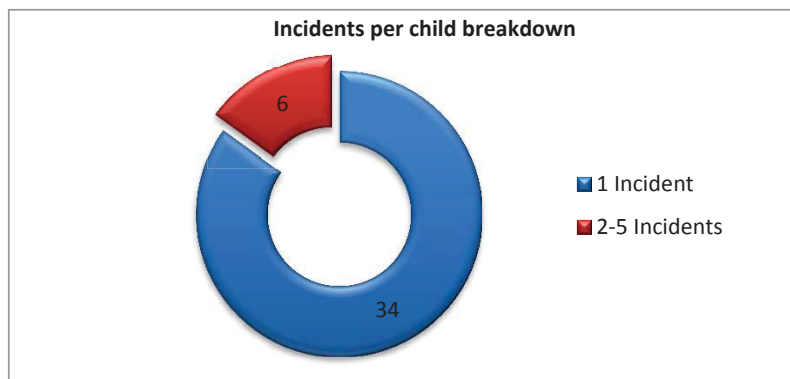
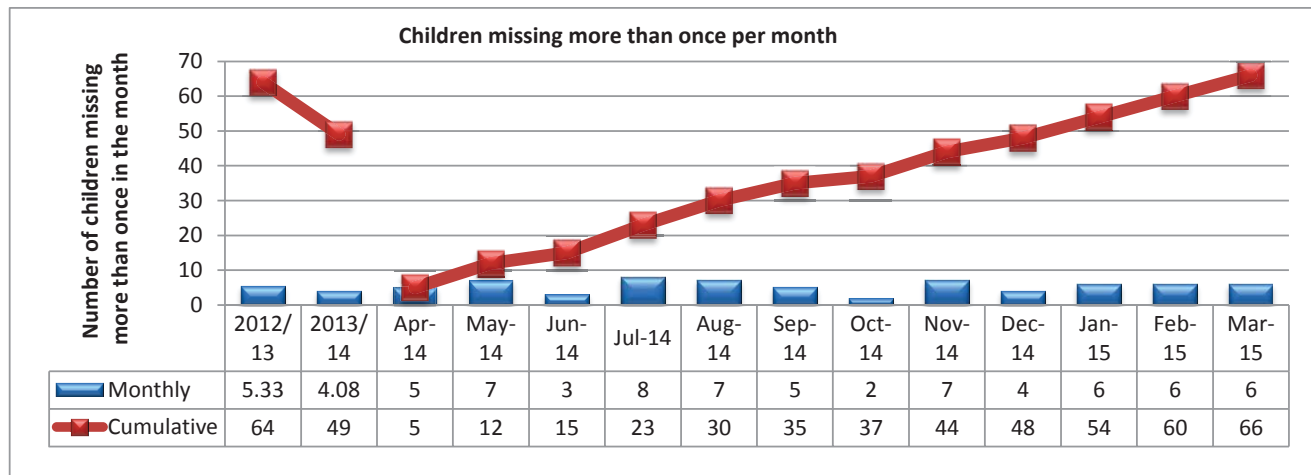

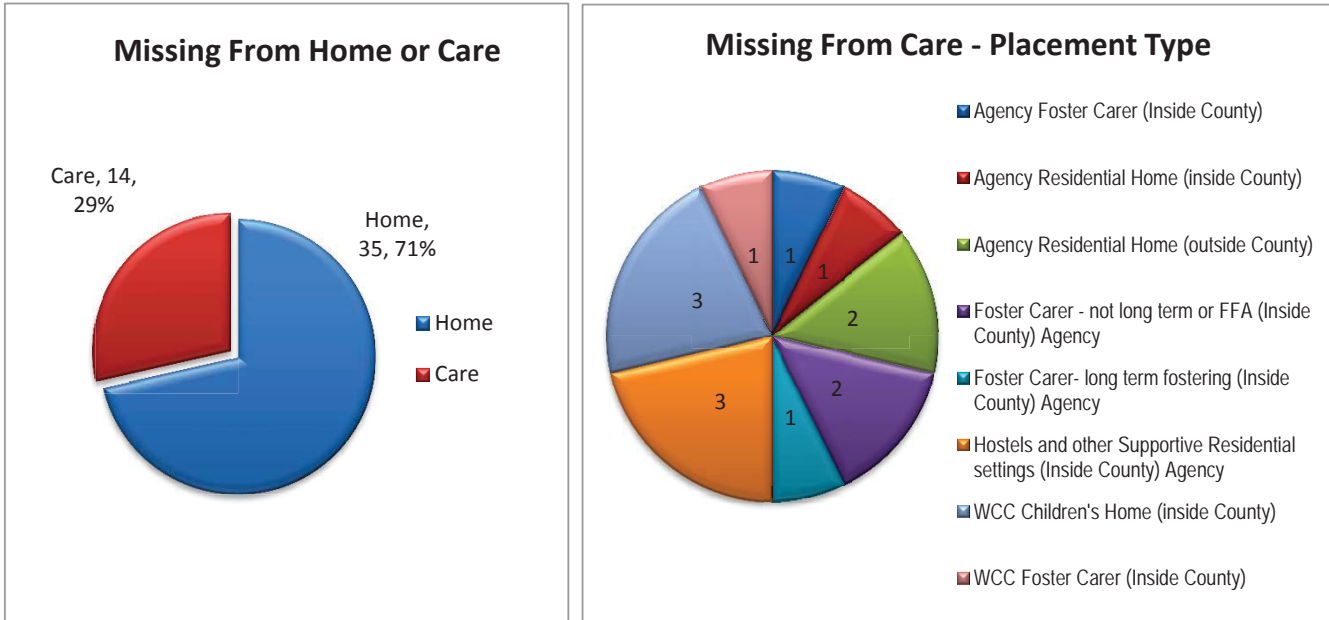

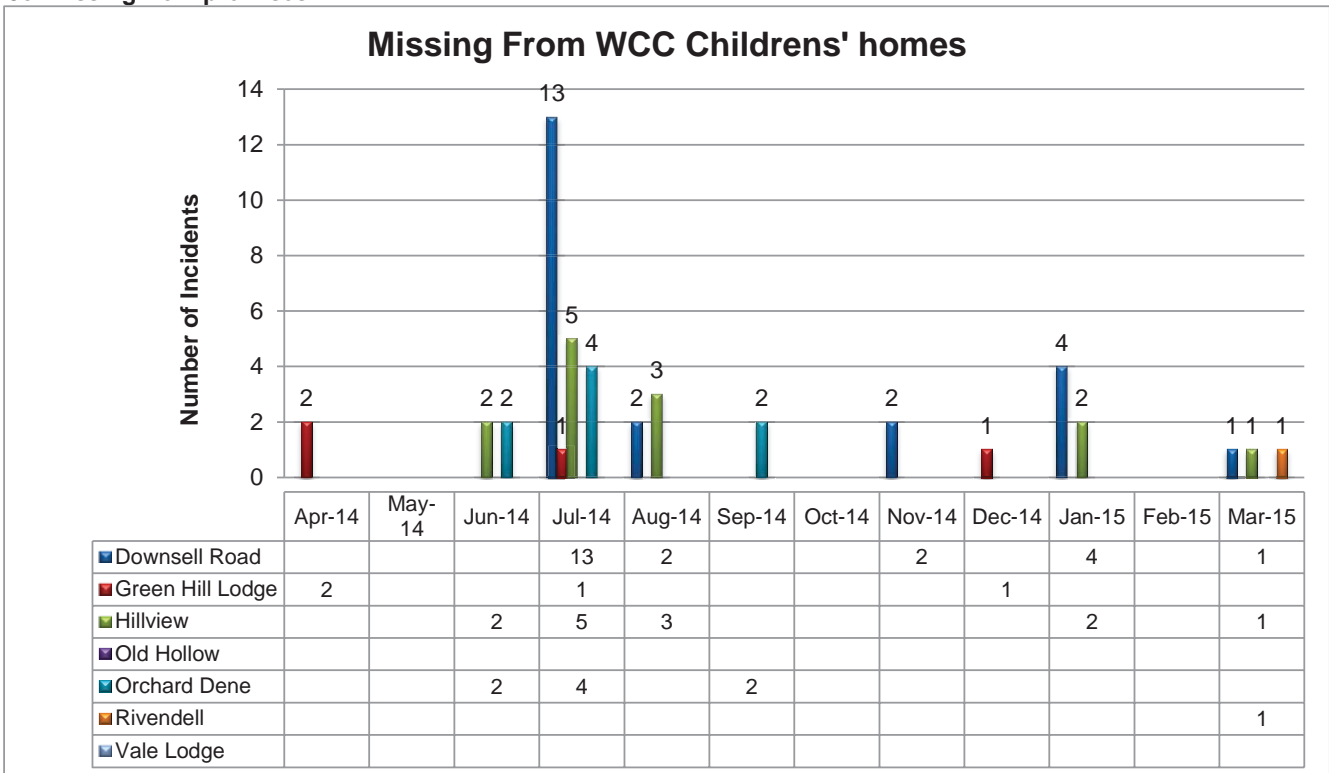

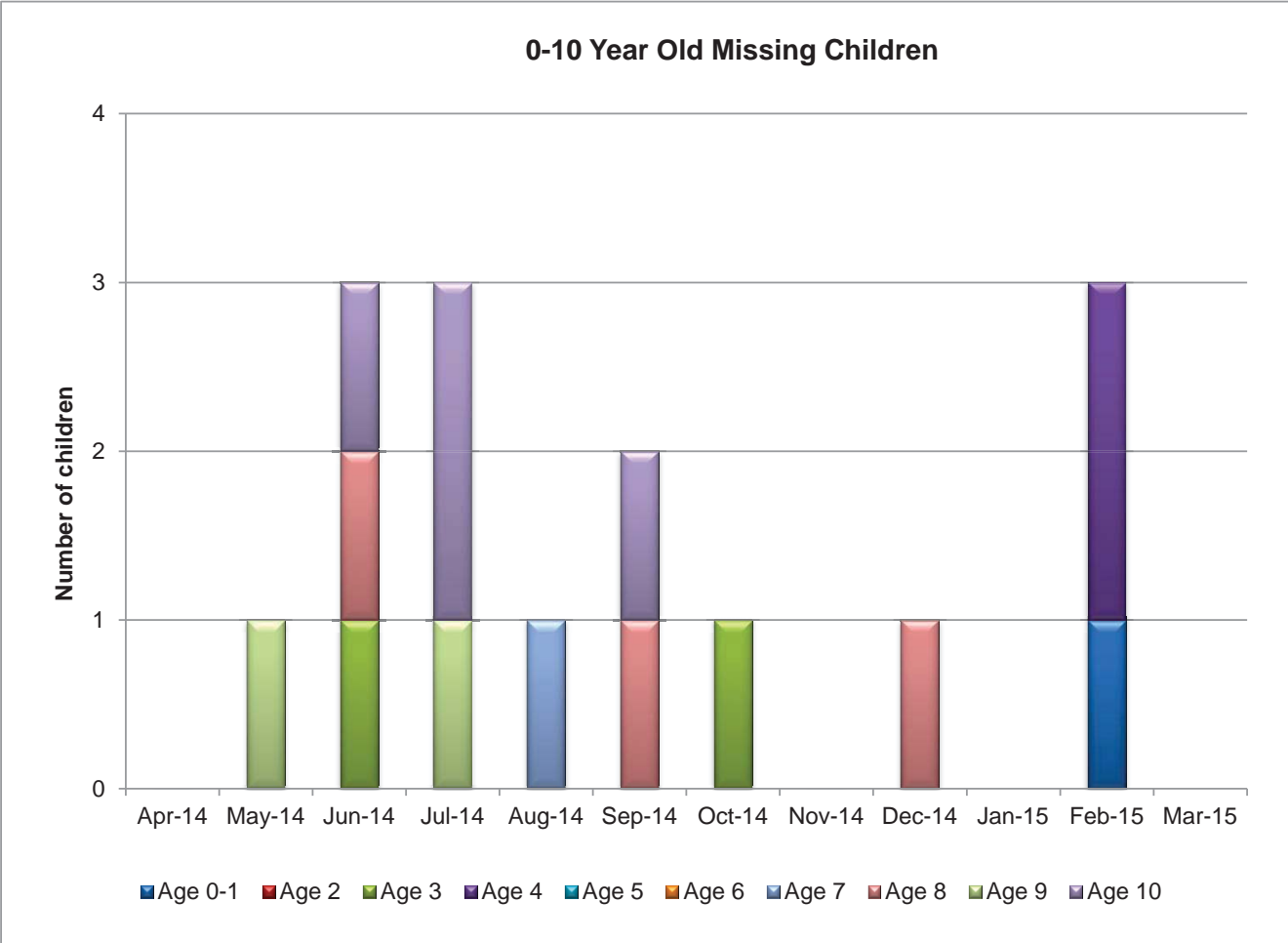

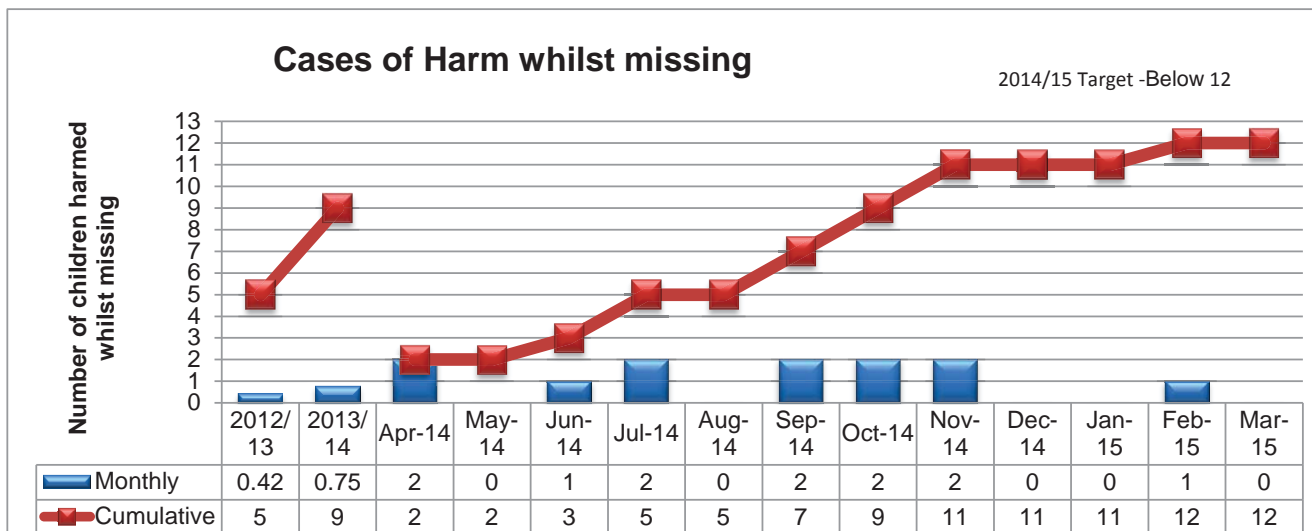

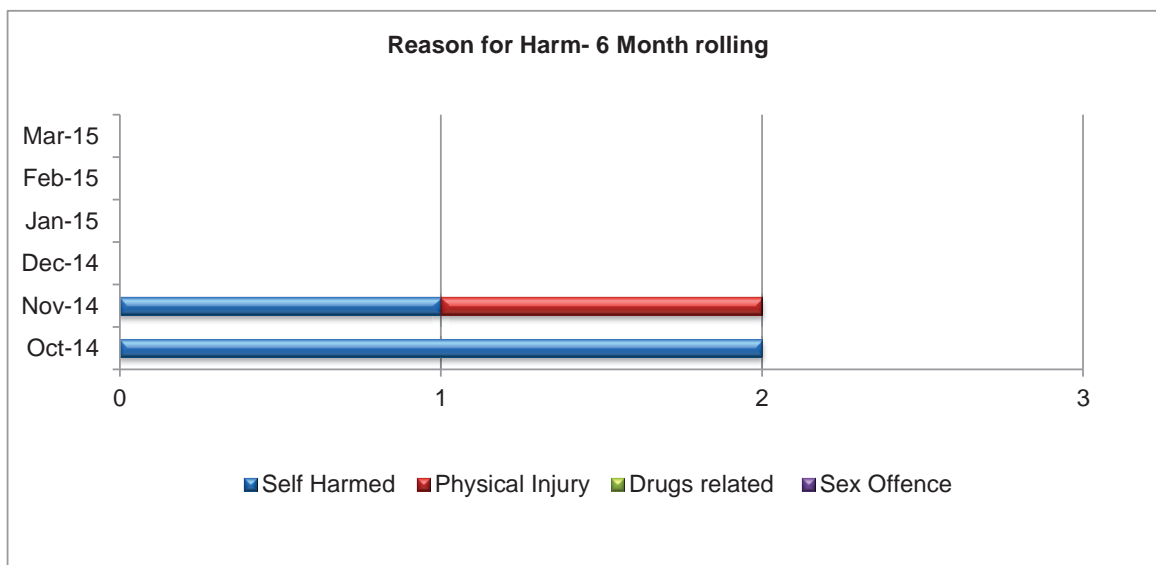

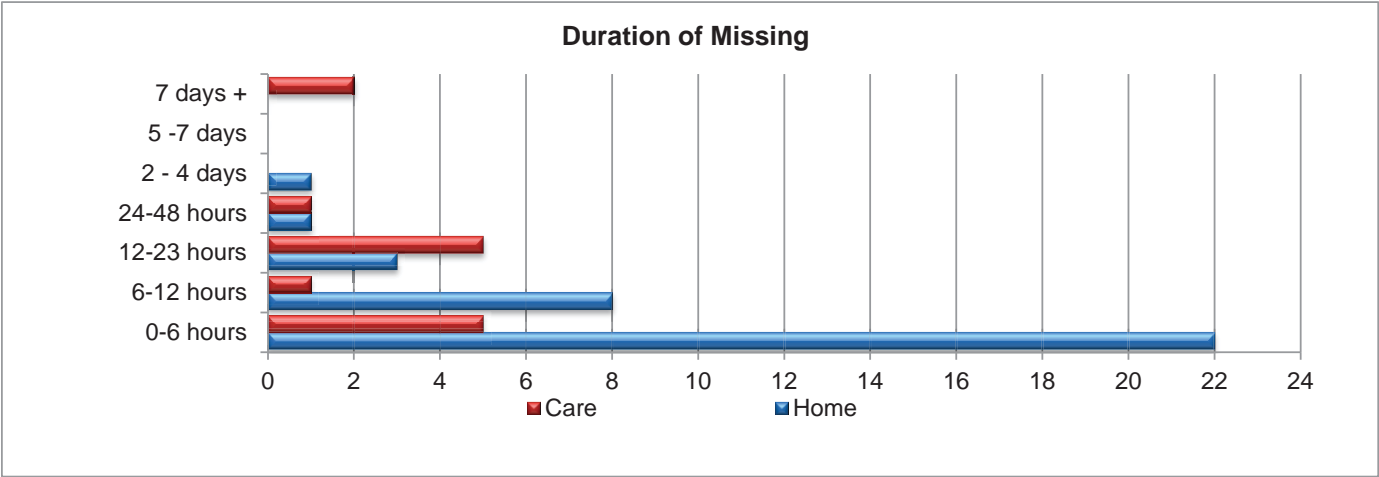

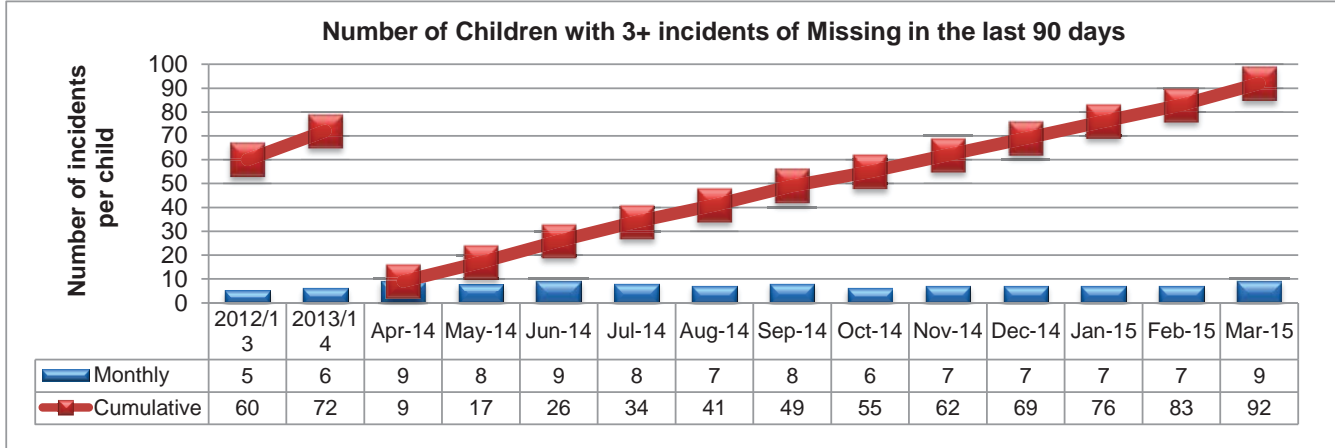

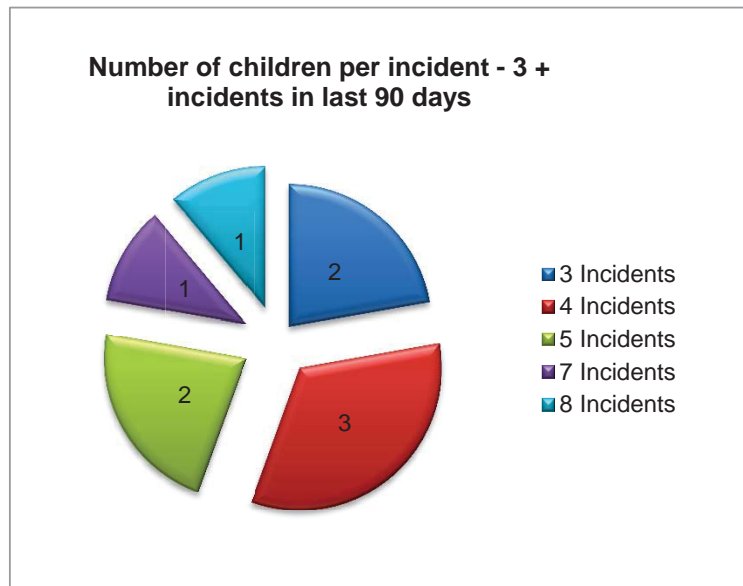
