Further Notices of Motion Received

- 9. "This Council notes with concern that the newly-elected Police and Crime Commissioner continues to occupy seats both on this Council and Wyre Forest District Council, thus making it difficult to fulfil the ability of the County and District Councillors on the Police and Crime Panel to hold the Police and Crime Commissioner to account.

We call upon the Police and Crime Commissioner to explain to this Council how we can hold him to account whilst he is still a member."

This should include 'caging' the bridge to reduce the risk to both the public crossing the bridge and for road users on the A448."
