Chairman's Visits and Functions Attended

1. A list of functions attended by the Chairman or Vice-Chairman of Council since the last meeting is attached.

Royal Visits to the County - HRH The Princess Royal

27 February 2023

- 2. HRH The Princess Royal was in the County on 27 February 2023 and visited Specsavers in Kidderminster, Green Lighting in Worcester and Pershore College.
- 3. The Chairman was presented to HRH at Specsavers in Kidderminster and accompanied the Royal Party around Pershore College.

4 April 2023

- 4. HRH The Princess Royal re-visited the County on 4 April 2023 to unveil the statue of The Sentry in Brockhill Village, Norton.
- 5. The Chairman was presented to HRH and remained with the Royal Party throughout the visit.

Death of Former Worcestershire County Councillor

- 6. Gordon Yarranton, a former Worcestershire County Councillor, sadly passed away on 10 April 2023.
- 7. He represented the Wolverley, Cookley and Wribbenhall Division for twelve years, from May 2005 to May 2017.
- 8. Gordon was elected to serve as Chairman of the Council for the 2013-14 civic year, a role he undertook with dedication and pride. He also sat on the Planning and Regulatory Committee for many years and was a member of the Hereford and Worcester Fire and Rescue Authority, as well as numerous outside bodies, representing the County Council.
- 9. During his political career, Gordon also served at District, Town and Parish level, and was elected Chairman of Wyre Forest District Council for the civic year 2010-11.
- 10. A funeral service was held on 10 May 2023 at St Leonard's Church, Ribbesford, Bewdley, followed by cremation at Wyre Forest Crematorium, which the Chairman attended.

11. Gordon was a hard-working and extremely dedicated Councillor who tirelessly served the community he represented and will be sadly missed by all who knew him.
