KETCH ROUNDABOUT UPDATE

Summary

1. The Director of Economy and Infrastructure and relevant officers have been invited to update the Panel on the Ketch Roundabout, in particular, to cover lessons learned.

Background

- 2. Concerns about the Ketch Roundabout redesign were discussed by the Panel on 24 June 2015. The Ketch roundabout forms part of a stretch of the A4440 road from Whittington to Powick roundabout in Worcester, which is subject to improvements due to capacity constraints.
- 3. Concerns about the roundabout had been highlighted by the Overview and Scrutiny Performance Board, which, given the degree of public concern, asked the Panel to look into the issues involved.
- 4. The scrutiny panel discussion involved the Cabinet Member for Economy, Skills and Infrastructure, the Director, and also the county councillor for Powick and local members for St Peters divisions.
